Often when starting up a new Agile software development project, people ask me the best way to document requirements. Many teams and Agile purists argue that a formal document is not necessary, that verbal communication and prototyping is sufficient, or that a card on a taskboard is enough transparency.

Given that the agile movement values working software over comprehensive documentation, you might well ask whether there is any place for a functional specification on an agile project. In Extreme Programming , the requirements are conveyed verbally, directly to the developer, with just a few notes scribbled on an index card as an aide memoire.

The answer is NOT simply user stories and acceptance criteria, or a traditional requirements document. Agile is just not that simple. This answer would focus on the wrong thing—output. A product requirements document (PRD) defines the value and purpose of a product or feature. It is written by the product manager to communicate what you are building, who it is for, and how it benefits the end user. It is often confused with a market requirements document (MRD), but they are different.

How would you go about modeling the requirements for a business application in an agile way? Requirements of an Agile project are gathered through user stories. Rather than a traditional "requirements" document, user stories are typically captured on index cards or sticky notes and arranged on walls or tables to facilitate planning and discussion.

If you're following Agile, Requirements Documentation is pretty much equal to your Product Backlog, Release Backlog and Sprint Backlogs. If you're following Waterfall, on the other hand, this could be a Business Requirements Document (BRD) template.

So, an Agile requirements document gathers user stories essential for a release. It still covers the same elements — purpose, features, release criteria, timeline.
