## Crime and Punishment in Ancient China

In Mainland China, there are 46 criminal offences eligible for the death penalty. These are defined in the criminal law of China, which comprehensively identifies criminal acts and their corresponding liabilities. A 2011 amendment to this law for the purpose of legal provisions improvement reduced the number of capital crimes by 19.1% and gave more lenient punishments to minors and the elderly. In 2015, the criminal code was amended to remove nine capital offences: Smuggling weapons or ammunitio

The first recorded death penalty laws can be traced all the way back to the reign of Hammurabi, a Babylonian king who ruled from 1792 BC to 1750 BC. There were upwards of 25 crimes that resulted in the death penalty, the code stipulated, including the theft of temple or palace property, or providing refuge to an escapee slave.
