To maintain national certification, you need to complete 100 hours of continuing medical education (CME) credits every two years and take a recertification exam (the Physician Assistant National Recertifying Exam, or PANRE) every 10 years. Become a PA: Getting Your Prerequisites and Certification ...

Individuals who have never been certified and who graduated from an ARC-PA accredited physician assistant program on or after January 1, 2003, will be eligible to take PANCE for up to six years after completing the requirements for graduation from that program. During that six-year period, PANCE may be taken a total of six times. When either the six attempts or six years are exhausted, whichever occurs sooner, the individual loses eligibility to take PANCE.

The standard degree for practicing physician assistants is a masters, which means you'll need to spend 4 years in undergraduate school obtaining bachelors, then 2 more to get the professional degree. That said, expect to take 2 years to become a physician assistant after you get your bachelors degree.
