A Career in Counseling While the work of getting suicidal individuals to seek out counseling or stay in treatment might fall within the realm of public awareness and educational campaigns, the work of helping individuals in treatment overcome suicidal thoughts resides with mental health counselors.

#### Counseling Options for Suicidal Individuals

For example, in the state of Oregon clinicians may be mandated to report suicidal behaviors in order to maintain the client 's safety and provide additional care (see ORS 419B.005, 40.262 R 507). Ethically, the most relevant issues involve confidentiality and avoidance of harm.

By framing behaviors this way, we can create a therapeutic container absent of judgment while also targeting feelings of shame that may contribute to the isolation many suicidal clients feel. "

### Confronting the threat of suicide - Counseling Today

Suicidal thoughts or acts cannot simply be thought of as a medical illness. Suicide challenges counsellors and health workers to engage empathically with complex psychosocial issues and to be open to understanding some of the deepest meanings people hold about their life (and potential death).

Suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States, and it is likely that every counselor will work with clients who have active suicidal ideation. Thus, it is critical that counselors understand risk factors for attempting or completing suicide as well as how to assess for suicidal ideation.

Safety when working with self-harming clients. With survivor clients, some of the hardest challenges of working in a model of empowerment emerge around issues of self-harm. 'Empowering clients' is especially hard when they are in hospital, in great distress, asking us to protect them, or suicidal (Saakvitne et al., 2000).
