In 1965, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a proclamation to make Ellis Island a National Monument. Before Ellis Island opened as the first federal immigration station, immigrants arriving in New York City were processed at Castle Garden, located at the tip of Manhattan. More than 11 million immigrants came through Castle Garden from 1820 to 1892. x

Ellis Island closed as an immigration center in 1956, about 60 years after it opened. Today, Ellis Island is a museum and is part of the Statue of Liberty National Monument, under the care of the National Park Service. You can visit the museum and see Ellis Island for yourself!

Ellis Island is in Upper New York Bay within New York Harbor, east of Liberty State Park and north of Liberty Island. While most of the island is in Jersey City, New Jersey, a small section is an exclave of New York City. The island has a land area of 27.5 acres (11.1 ha), much of which is from land reclamation.
