*Why did God choose Moses to save his people if he was a ...*

Isaiah 42:1 says. God called Him to be elect. "Elect", bachiyr, means chosen, choice one, chosen one, the elect of God, so we cannot deny that God chooses who will be elect. The root, bachar, merely repeats and underlines these meanings and facts, and includes the meaning of 'selected' and to 'decide for'.

While God chose to work with the ancient nation of Israel, this decision did not exclude people of other nations (gentiles) from coming to understand God and serve Him. God instructed the ancient Israelites that they were to respect peoples of other nationalities who came to live among God's chosen people.

God decided at a prior time to bring you to belief, to open your eyes, and to give you repentance. And then I would turn to Ephesians 1:4: "Even as he chose [i.e., elected] us in him before the foundation of the world." God decided to save you before he actually did it. He is not whimsical. He doesn't get taken off guard.

Why in the world would Paul give us such a teaching here? There are a lot of answers to that question, but I want to say this morning that believing the plain teaching ...

Paul's answer comes in Romans 9:6: "It is not as though the word of God has failed." Then he gives his basic answer why: "For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel." That's his basic answer.

God's Election. This is why Paul could write that God "chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will" (Eph 1:4-5).

When the Scripture speaks about God's electing people, God speaks of electing people in Christ; our salvation is rooted and grounded in Jesus. What that makes me think is this: You and I are saved not only because of God's concern for us but chiefly and ultimately for God's total determination to honor his obedient Son.

So which is it? Do we choose God or does he choose us? It's a sticky question - one that has divided people for centuries. If God chose me, does that mean that I don't have any free will? Does that mean that my choices aren't really choices at all? Does that mean that I'm nothing more than a puppet on a divine string?

Clearly, Paul is distinguishing those on whom God set His purpose to save from the rest of humanity. Thus God's foreknowledge contains the concept of His foreordination of people and events. God chose us to be holy and blameless. Both of these words look at our sanctification, but from slightly different angles.

It is our sin in Adam and the nature we bear because of that, that condemns all men to hell. As all men go to hell, God, in his marvelous grace, saves some. The rest are damned, but not simply because of the sin in Adam--primarily because of the sin of unbelief.

God chose Moses, Abraham, David and others in spite of their sin. He chose them because of the child-like faith and because of their willingness to repent. The same is true today.

Answer: "If God loves us and wants us to spend eternity with Him, why doesn't He just save everyone now?" This question and others like it often keep people from seeking God further, as they assume that this question is the mountain that cannot be scaled. But the question itself is based upon some faulty assumptions.

Clearly, we see that God chose us for salvation ( Ephesians 1:4; 2 Thessalonians 2:13) But, on the other hand, we do freely choose God because not only does God choose us, but he enables us to choose him granting to us what we need. John 6:28-29, "Therefore they said to Him, "What shall we do,..."

God chose us because He has a purpose in mind for our lives. The Old Testament focuses on Israel as God's chosen people (Deuteronomy 7:6). In Deuteronomy 7:7-9 Moses tells the children of Israel why God chose them: "The Lord did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples.
