#1 Be Strong and Flexible. When you're climbing or pedaling a smooth trail, you often want to stay in the saddle. But when you're riding technical terrain, especially descending, stand on your pedals with a slight bend in your knees, waist, and elbows. It's an athletic stance that helps absorb bumps in the trail.

So to recap, the first step to becoming a mountain guide is to gain the proper climbing and/or backcountry skiing experience. If you are just starting out, this could take many years.
