An articulated vehicle is a vehicle which has a pivot joint. This allows the vehicle to turn more sharply. There are many kinds of articulated vehicles: buses, trams and trains may be articulated. Steam locomotives were sometimes articulated so the driving wheels could pivot around turns. In fact, the whole idea of a train is an articulated set of vehicles which run along a track.
