An APA Style citation for a journal article includes the author name(s), publication year, article title, journal name, volume and issue number, page range of the article, and a DOI (if available).

How to cite a journal article in MLA style. Published on April 16, 2019 by Courtney Gahan. Revised on October 26, 2020. An MLA Works Cited entry for a journal article contains the author(s); article title; journal name; volume and issue; month and year; page range; and a DOI if accessed online. In the in-text citation, include the author's last name and the page number.

Article Summary X. To cite journal articles in APA, start by listing the last name and first initial for each author, using an ampersand instead of the word "and" to separate them. Next, include the publication date in parentheses, followed by a period. Then, write the article title with only the first word capitalized, and end it with a period.

How to reference a journal article in Harvard style. Published on 20 May 2020 by Jack Caulfield. Revised on 4 June 2020. In Harvard style, to reference a journal article, you need the author name(s), the year, the article title, the journal name, the volume and issue numbers, and the page range on which the article appears.

For an APA citation journal article from a database, you are not required to include the database information. This is because APA format includes a link to the website or the DOI instead, since database information can change over time. Simply follow the format for an APA citation journal from online as described above.

If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. Always include the issue number for a journal article. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page). The reference in this case is the same as for a print journal article.

A journal article retrieved from a library database can be referenced as though it were a print journal. The essential elements you require to create a journal article reference include: Author or authors including surname and initial. [Call out: include the second initial if available]; Year of publication, Title of article.

An article from an online journal may also require a different citation format from a print journal article. The basics of most citation styles are readily available online. In-Text Citations for a Journal Article in Harvard Referencing. To cite a journal article, you need to provide the author's surname and the year of publication (separated by a comma) in parentheses: The yellow plumage indicates a blue tit's diet (Couzens, 2010). If you name the author(s) in the text, only the year of publication is required:

How To Reference Journal Article

While many articles you will use in your references appear in academic and professional journals, you might also find articles in magazines, newspapers, and online publications. The reference section is one of the easiest places to lose points due to incorrect APA format, so always check your references before you hand in your psychology papers .

Journal Article - Citation Help for APA, 7th Edition ...

A basic reference list entry for a journal article in APA must include: Author or authors. The surname is followed by first initials. Year of publication of the article (in round brackets). Article title. Journal title (in italics). Volume of journal (in italics). Issue number of journal in round brackets (no italics). Page range of article ...

Guides: How to reference a Journal in Harvard style - Cite ...

All journal articles will include the issue number. Regardless, of whether or not the journal is continuously paginated. All articles coming from an academic database should be treated as a print journal. If the article has a DOI, include the DOI at the end of the reference. If the article does not have a DOI, then omit from the reference.

Citing a Journal Article in APA - BibMe

When you have found the journal homepage, you can copy and paste the URL into your citation. Here is an APA citation for the article from the Journal of Interactive Online Learning —the journal whose homepage we found. Because the article does not have a DOI, the APA citation ends with "Retrieved from" followed by the URL of the journal homepage:
