The Guidelines acknowledge that during the last two years there have been few reported decisions on quantum for the editorial team to review.

Interestingly, the introduction to Chapter 7 of the Guidelines takes into consideration the looming Civil Liability Act 2018 reforms on road-traffic accident (RTA) claims and the planned introduction of a fixed tariff scheme for whiplash injuries.
