Answer: You may use your maiden name when you renew. Just make sure to book tickets in your maiden name as well. When you get back from your honeymoon, you may apply for a passport name change. If you apply within a year of the passport's issuance, you do not need to pay any fee unless you request for expedited service.

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Three-Year Rule for Naturalization Eligibility After ...

In order for your spouse to have gotten a U visa with you, as a derivative, you would both have had to have been married to each other at the time that you applied for the U visa. According to the facts you've set forward, you got married after you applied for your U visa, such that your spouse does not qualify as your derivative.

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After receiving a U visa, can I get my new spouse a U visa ...

If your name changed due to marriage then you need to apply for a passport name change before you travel. If your passport was issued less than a year ago, there is no fee. If it was issued more
