Women often struggle to exit prostitution, and when they do, many find themselves returning after a temporary reprieve, due to difficulties finding a stable home and income. Many are affected by mental health problems, low self esteem and anxiety about life outside of prostitution.

In a 1998 survey of 475 women who were involved in prostitution, ninety-two percent of them said they wanted to leave prostitution but couldn’t because they lack basic human services such as a home, job training, health care, counseling and treatment for drug or alcohol addiction. 1 Another reason a prostituted woman might not leave prostitution is that she may be afraid of what her pimp will do to her and ...
