When adjusting an oboe, two methods are used. First, use the cigarette paper to check that the adjustment is not too tight. Then play-test the oboe, feeling for vibrations on the secondary key to make sure nothing is too loose. The adjustment screws regulate the pressure of the keys that you do not touch during normal playing conditions.

Finally, there is the process of assembly and adjustment. The key posts are embedded, the parts forming the keys are incorporated into the bar-affixed pipe, and the pads are fitted on. Then, the motions among the keys are fixed using adjustment screws, and the instrument is complete. Because the oboe has so many parts and they are all complexly interrelated, several days are required to assemble and adjust a single instrument.

If the oboe has no adjustment screw, then a bit of tape or cork on the body of the oboe beneath the half-hole key lever can work. If the height of the key becomes too low, the C-sharp6 will not speak easily.

3. There are times when a tone-hole can become a bit clogged with debris, such as lint.

Always adjust the reed for function, not tone. There are four basic criteria for reed function: 1. response 2. resistance 3. tone quality 4. stability. Adjusting for anyone of these criteria will directly affect other aspects - there is no simple solution.

Try soaking the reed for a good long time (15-20 minutes) and see if it improves. Squeezing it gently open with you fingers is a temporary solution. Some people recommend changing the shape of the tube with pliers to adjust the opening, but this distorts the reed and ruins the tube.

Cut a short length of fish-skin or Teflon tape and wrap it around the reed, overlapping the thread and cane, and extending onto the cane approximately 1/4" (or just enough to cover the leak). The Teflon tape will last about as long as the reed will, but it also may be removed and/or replaced at any time.

Your oboe cane (start with 10.5mm-11.0mm diameter,.60-.45mm gouge, Gilbert#1 or similar shape), staples (47mm, clean, good socket fit, identical fit on mandrel), oboe (in perfect repair), work acoustics (as "dead" as possible), and even work light should be identical each time you pick up a piece of cane.

Take a toothpick or skewer and blunt the end. Then insert it into the hole as shown and break it off. This leaves some material for the screw to hold on to. Use a needle to poke a hole fairly deeply into the center of the toothpick. Turn in the screw....
