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College Guidelines - American College of Surgeons

REGULATION 35 . OFFICE-BASED SURGERY . A physician shall not perform any office-based surgery, as defined by Act 587 of 2013, unless the office meets the requirements of this regulation. Except in an emergency, a physician shall not perform any office-based surgery on and after July 1, 2014, unless they are in compliance

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Office-Based Surgery | American Society of Plastic Surgeons

Practitioners performing office-based surgery (OBS) should be familiar with the laws and leading issues associated with OBS procedures. Although the precise definition varies from state-to-state, an OBS procedure is generally any surgical or diagnostic procedure performed in a physician's medical office that is invasive or involves subcutaneous penetration, excluding minor surgical procedures.

Office Based Surgery is any surgery or surgical procedure: excision, or resection, partial or complete destruction, incision or other structural alteration of human tissue by any means; including but not limited to lasers, pulsed light, radio frequency, or medical microwave devise; not exempted by these rules, upon the body of a living human being for the purpose of preserving health ...

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
