*HIPAA Privacy Rule*

Generally, HIV-related information can only be disclosed if the person signs an approved HIV release form. The Department of Health form, HIPAA Compliant Authorization for Release of Medical Information and Confidential HIV Related Information (DOH 2557) , is used for this purpose.

HIV status and reporting requirements raise legal issues related to patient confidentiality. Legal protection of patient privacy and confidentiality depends on whether or not public health concerns outweigh the interest in preserving the doctor-patient privilege.

Confidentiality and Disclosure. Disclosing one's HIV status is still widely perceived as socially dangerous. Similarly, another great risk people living with HIV face is the inadvertent or improper disclosure of their status which can result in denial of employment, violence, and many other collateral consequences.

(6) Limiting the use or disclosure of, and requests for, protected health information to the minimum necessary to accomplish an intended purpose, when being transmitted by or on behalf of a covered entity under HIPAA, is a key component of health information privacy. The disclosure of HIV-related information, when allowed by this Act, shall be performed in accordance with the minimum necessary standard when required under HIPAA.

In addition to privacy requirements under the Health Insurance Portability and Privacy Act (HIPPA), information about HIV infection and certain other conditions are specially protected in Federal law. Release of information related to testing or treatment for HIV can only be released with the written permission of the patient.

The right to privacy and confidentiality varies by state, but one thing holds true across the board: The more people to whom you voluntarily disclose your HIV-positive status, the harder it is to claim the right to keep it private.

Knowing your HIV status, telling it to your sexual partners, and having them tell you their status before you start having sex may help reduce risky behaviors and lessen the chances of getting or transmitting HIV. Sometimes, though, people don't know, are wrong about, or aren't honest about their HIV status.

Understanding first and foremost that we have the obligation to protect the privacy of our patients is key. Beyond that, knowing that everyone goes through a unique process of disclosure is also important. Individuals with HIV may disclose upon diagnosis or choose to never reveal their status.

*Disclosures of HIV Test Results*

In California, there is a statute that specifically relates to HIV/AIDS and privacy. Without getting too deeply into its many provisions, the statute allows a physician and surgeon who has the results of a confirmed positive test to detect HIV infection to disclose to a spouse or sexual partner certain limited information.

The HIPAA Privacy Rule ensures that the medical data of a patient with HIV is restricted in its use and disclosure to only the minimum necessary required for a particular task.

As required by the HIPAA law itself, state laws that provide greater privacy protection (which may be those covering mental health, HIV infection, and AIDS information) continue to apply.

Privacy and disclosure of one's HIV status can be particularly sensitive in the employment arena. A potential employer is not allowed to ask you about your HIV status.

Your medical information (including your HIV status) is protected by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act's (HIPAA) Privacy Rule and cannot be released without your permission except in circumstances where not disclosing the information could result in harm to another person.

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
