Program planning is the process by which a program is conceived and brought to fruition. Program planning involves multiple steps including the identification of a problem, selection of desired outcomes, assessment of available resources, implementation, and evaluation of the program.

1. Plans are based on theory; Programs are based on results. Plans document policies and procedures. They outline "what-if" scenarios. Programs discuss relationships and interdependent roles. In essence, plans are about "what-if", and programs are about "what-is".

Plans vs. Programs
