There is an excitement in the field about “seeding approaches” to reverse the effects of C-section delivery mode on the microbiome in early life, but there is an equal level of concern about the widespread utility and safety of this approach. 102, 105 Thus, targeted nutritional or environmental interventions and readjustments in obstetrical and newborn medicine practices may be the best strategies to compensate for early-life microbiota disturbances in the future .
