Emergency shelter is temporary housing for homeless individuals living outside or in places not meant for human habitation. In general, emergency shelters address the basic health, food, clothing and personal hygiene needs of the households and refer them to supportive services and permanent housing.

IDHS—Emergency & Transitional Housing Program

To assist with siting the temporary emergency shelter, the City Council also passed Ordinance 28432, which adopted interim zoning and land use controls as an emergency measure to permit the City to site temporary emergency shelters in response to the declared emergency.
