A Tiptronic (or Sportmatic, or Steptronic, or any number of marketing names for it) is a type of automatic transmission that allows the driver to shift gears as they would with a manual transmission. It's different from a computer controlled manual transmission in that it does allow automatic shifting, uses a torque converter instead of a clutch, and the driver doesn't have full control over which gear the car is in.

Tiptronic refers to a transmission that can be used in automatic mode but also switched to a manual mode, where the driver controls the shifts with either steering wheel mounted buttons or by toggling the shift lever up and down in a gearshift gate. The gate has a "+" and "-" sign, the plus for upshifting and the minus sign for downshifting.

This isn't your grandmother's automatic in her Ford Granada. A Tip has 5 shifting maps to accommodate different driving environments. You can also set the trans entering a corner to a gear that will net 5400 rpm's by burping the throttle. On hard acceleration the trans shifts at 6400 rpms, the peak hp rpm.

Tiptronic S. With the version Tiptronic S, which was first used in the 1995 model of the Porsche 993, shift paddles were added to the steering wheel. The function of the manual shifting was thereby transferred from the shift knob additionally to the steering wheel, which was not usual at the time.

The Tiptronic S is an upgrade to the original Tiptronic, with the ability to adapt to driver's behaviour, and also allows driver to change gears without entering manual mode. In manual mode, if there is no driver input for a period of eight seconds, the system reverts to automatic mode. It was used as early as 2000 in the Porsche Boxster.
