The cam tool for the 1.6 will work on a 1Z and AHU. For the record, you're supposed to remove the cam pulley to do a 1.6 timing belt as well. The pulleys are not keyed. It's easier to fit the belt with the pulley completely off the end of the cam. Put the pulley into the belt, then reinstall on the end of the cam.

In order for your VW Cabrio to drive smoothly, the crankshaft must turn at precisely twice the speed of the camshaft. The camshaft is responsible for opening and closing the engine intake and exhaust valves where internal combustion actually takes.

loosen/remove the belt again and turn the camshaft until the marks align. Make sure you don't move the distributor rotor! If you have an '80s K-Jetronic engine you probably have the metal belt cover, which exposed both sides of the crank pulley when removed. You should be able to see the timing mark: a dimple, notch, or painted dot.

Some special tools are required. A flat bar, VW tool no. 2065A, is used to secure the camshaft in position. A pin, VW tool no. 2064, is used to fix the pump position while the timing belt is removed. The camshaft and pump work against spring pressure and will move out of position when the timing belt is removed.
