First, however, you must get your wood stove set up properly. One of the most important parts of setting up your wood stove is connecting it to the stovepipe. A stovepipe can either be single wall or close clearance or two walls. A stovepipe will then connect the stove to a metal or masonry chimney.

Install the stove in the center of your home with the chimney running straight up through the warm part of your house. Limit the number of bends in the chimney and make sure to use insulated high temperature pipe. Match the flue size to the flue collar on the stove. A tall chimney is a happy chimney.

Download our Chimney Pipe Installation Guide now. Minimum chimney height, at sea level, of a straight or vertical chimney is 10 feet to 15 feet above the appliance outlet. Higher elevations, or the use of an elbow or a tee, will require approximately 30% to 60% more height to provide for an adequate draft.

Install chimney according to chimney manufacturers instructions. The performance of your wood fire is governed to a very large part by the chimney system. Too short a chimney can cause difficult start-up, dirty glass, back smoking when door is open, and even reduced heat output.

How To Install Wood Stove Pipe Through Wall. Installing a wood burning stove means you will need stovepipe. Stovepipe differs from chimney systems. Stove pipes, or chimney connectors, can be either single or double walled. Installation depends on the route used for the vent pipes: vertical, horizontal, or a

The installation of wood heaters, however, is regulated by Australian Standard AS/NZS 2918. Australian Standard AS/NZS 2918:2001 requires a minimum flue height of 4.6 metres above the floor on which the wood heater is located.
